Independent Auditor's Report

To the Office of the City Clerk of Mississauga

Report on the Financial Statements

We have audited the accompanying financial statements of the Frank Dale, candidate, which comprises of the calculation of surplus or deficit at December 31, 2014 and the statement of campaign income and expenses for the period then ended.

Candidate's Responsibility for the Financial Statements

The candidate is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of these financial statements in accordance with Section 78 the *Municipal Elections Act*, 1996, and for such internal control as he determines is necessary to enable the preparation of financial statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

Auditor's Responsibility

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audit. We conducted our audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards. Accordingly, our verification of these transactions was limited to ensuring the amounts recorded in the accounting records of Frank Dale, candidate, and we were not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to income and expenses, assets or liabilities, and surplus/deficit.

Qualified Opinion

In our opinion, except for the possible effects of the matter described in the Basis for Qualified Opinion paragraph, the financial information present fairly, in all material respects, the income and expenses for the campaign period from January 27, 2014 to December 31, 2014 and the calculation of the surplus or deficit in accordance with accounting treatment prescribed by the *Municipal Elections Act*, 1996.

Basis of Accounting and Restriction on Distribution

Without modifying our opinion, we draw attention to the basis of accounting. The Municipal Election Act, 1996 does not require us to report, nor was it practicable for us to determine, that contributions reported include only those which may be properly retained in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996. This financial information, which has not been, and was not intended to be, prepared in accordance with Canadian generally accepted accounting principles is solely for the information and use of the Office of the City Clerk, Mississauga, for complying with the Municipal Elections Act, 1996.
