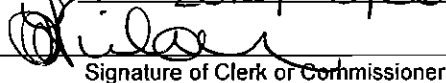

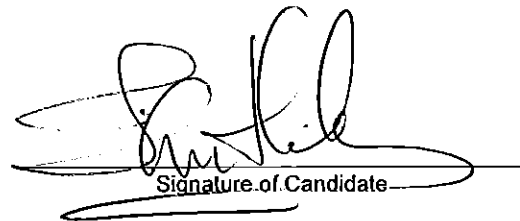

## AUDITORS' REPORT

### MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS ACT, 1996 (SECTION 78)

To: Crystal Greer, City Clerk

We have audited the Statement of Assets and Liabilities, the Statement of Campaign Period Income and Expenses, and the Statement of Determination of Surplus or Deficit and Disposition of Surplus of Kiru Kulendiren, candidate, for the campaign period from June 18, 2014 to December 31, 2014 relating to the election held on October 27, 2014. These financial statements are the responsibility of Kiru Kulendiren, candidate. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audit.

Except as explained in the following paragraph, we conducted our audit in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards. Those standards require that we plan and perform an audit to obtain reasonable assurance whether the financial statements are free of material misstatement. An audit includes examining, on a test basis, evidence supporting the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. An audit also includes assessing the accounting principles used and significant estimates made by Kiru Kulendiren, candidate, as well as evaluating the overall financial statement presentation.

Due to the nature of the types of transactions inherent in an election campaign, it is impracticable through auditing procedures to determine that the accounting records include all donations of goods and services, and receipts and disbursements. Accordingly, our verification of these transactions was limited to ensuring that the financial statements reflect the amounts recorded in the accounting records of Kiru Kulendiren, candidate, in accordance with the accounting procedures established by the **Municipal Elections Act, 1996** and we were not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to income and expenses, assets or liabilities, and surplus/deficit.

In our opinion, except for the effect of adjustments, if any, which we might have determined to be necessary had we been able to satisfy ourselves as to the completeness of the records as described in the preceding paragraph, these financial statements present fairly, in all material respects, the financial position of the candidate's election campaign as at December 31, 2014 and the income and expenses for the campaign period from June 18, 2014 to December 31, 2014 and the determination of surplus or deficit and the disposition of surplus in accordance with the accounting treatment prescribed by the **Municipal Elections Act, 1996**.

The **Municipal Elections Act, 1996** does not require us to report, nor was it practicable for us to determine, that contributions reported include only those which may be properly retained in accordance with the provisions of the **Municipal Elections Act, 1996**.
